BY-LAW NO. 10-373

**Being a by-law to adopt the 2010 Accessibility Plan
for the Township of South Algonquin.**

WHEREAS the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA)* requires all municipalities to have an Accessibility Plan, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin has completed an Accessibility Plan in accordance with the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (ADOA)*, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin will review and update their Accessibility Plan annually, and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin enacts as follows:

“To adopt the 2010 Accessibility Plan as revised for the Township of South Algonquin and that By-Law 06-257 is hereby repealed by this By-Law”.
